

We also had a very successful Section 48 Inspection; this looks at the Catholic life of the school and the teaching and learning of RE. The outcome of this inspection will be shared with you at the beginning of the Autumn Term as the report will not be released until the end of July. It will make for great reading!

### Reading for Pleasure



We will begin Autumn Term with a celebration of '100 years of Roald Dahl' for Years 2 – 6. Year 1, Reception and Nursery children will celebrate '150 years of Beatrix Potter.'

During the summer holiday it would be wonderful if the children in Year 2 and KS2 could read some Roald Dahl books or if you could read to your child.



For Year 1 and EYFS please try to share with your child some books by Beatrix Potter, with those wonderful characters such as Peter Rabbit and Squirrel Nutkin.

During the summer holiday it is so important that the children continue to read regularly. **If your child reads for 15 minutes every day this will add up to 630 minutes.**

A commitment to this small amount of time daily can make a very big difference to your child!

**Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> July** – Sports Day for Years 1-6 from 1.30pm at Bacon's College.


All parents and family members are welcome; however there is no entry into the Bacon's College Sports Ground until 1.20pm for parents.


