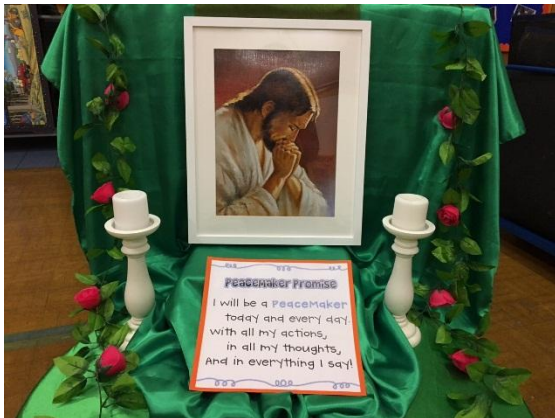

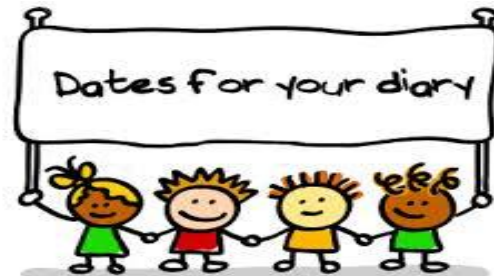
This picture shows the focal area they set up for assembly this week on the theme of Peace.

EYFS
