Outstanding Behaviour



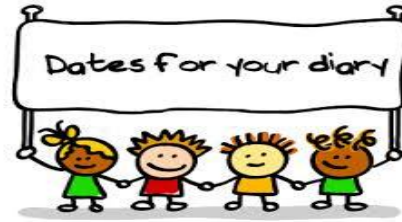
St John's has the highest expectation for behaviour from all members of its school community. We are proud of our children and how they behave. It was noted by Ofsted in 2011 and again in 2016 that behaviour is outstanding.

There may be an occasion that a member of staff may speak to you, regarding a time when your child may have misbehaved. We ask that you take responsibility, to support your child in understanding that the same high expectations for behaviour are shared between school and home. Making excuses for their behaviour will not help your child to develop a good moral code for the future.

Flu vaccination

We were notified earlier this term that all children in Years 1, 2 and 3 will be offered the flu vaccination through a **nasal spray**. This date has now been confirmed for Thursday 15th December 2016.

Later this week you will receive a consent form and a covering letter from Hounslow and Richmond Community Healthcare NHS Trust who now run the Lambeth & Southwark School Age Immunisation Team. Please return the consent form even if you DO NOT consent to the vaccination for your child, explaining the reason for your decision. This will help in the development of the flu vaccination programme in the future.
