Autumn Term Curriculum




During the first half of the Autumn Term, the children will be learning about 'Families.'

We will be reading and retelling stories about families and will be creating a display based on the story 'Peace at Last'.



We will also be learning an array of counting rhymes and nursery rhymes.













During the second half of the Autumn Term, the children will be learning about colour. We will introduce the three primary colours and we will be experimenting with what happens to these colours when they are mixed together. During this topic the children will have the opportunity to use various media such as paints, water colours, pencils, chalks and pastels and we look forward to seeing their masterpieces.



The scope of learning will cover the seven areas of development in the Foundation Stage.



Reminders

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- Please give your child a labelled **water** bottle every day.
 - Please ensure that your child brings their book bag into Nursery every day so that we can put their pictures and school letters in it, as well as a sharing book.
 - Children take home a sharing book on Tuesday and Friday. Please ensure that you read this to your child and write a comment in their reading record. It is important that you talk to your child about the story and pictures and make this a fun time for them.
 - A change of clothes is needed in the event of an accident, please ensure they are clearly labelled.
 - Please check all garments are marked with your child's name.
 - It is essential that you inform the nursery staff if your child has or develops an allergy.
 - Please dress your child in loose clothing that is easier for them to manage i.e. track suit bottoms or leggings.
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
