In addition, the children will have grammar homework as they complete their revision for the tests. After SATs, the focus will be on writing in different styles linked to the many different trips and activities we have planned for the children. The children will be concentrating on the quality and presentation of their written work.



Maths



In the run up to the SATs tests, please support your children with all Maths homework set, including practice papers. The pupils in Year 6 will be working on problem solving, data handling, graph work and money (financial skills) after the SATs tests.

ICT

We will be using our ICT sessions for online revision leading up to the SATs. After the tests, Year 6 will design and create their very own animations linked to our topic.

TOPIC

The topic for this term is London. This will be a cross curricular theme and will include a study of Victorian Theatre as well as work surrounding our local area.
