### KS1

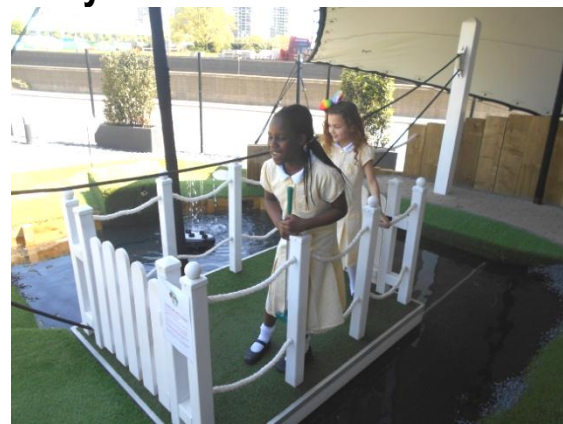
