English


Maths



Children will be working on securing their knowledge of numbers to 20, counting forwards and backwards. We will begin to add and subtract numbers using a range of apparatus for support e.g. objects, number lines and 100 squares. The children will learn about 2D shapes and will develop their understanding of length and time, beginning to tell the time to the hour.



Topic



Our topic this term is Traditional Tales. We will be looking at several different traditional tales. One example of this is Little Red Riding Hood, where we will explore our local
