Tickets are £1 per strip.

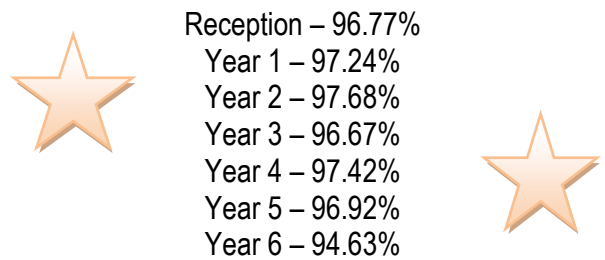
