

Year 3 Newsletter Spring 2020

Welcome back to the start of the term! Please find below an outline of the Year 3 learning journey for this term.

English



Our first English topic this term is linked to the text 'Jim—A Cautionary Tale.' The children will be writing about the characters, sequencing the story and discussing the themes of the book. This will lead to planning, writing and publishing their own story on a similar theme. The class will also be looking at texts linked to our topic Ancient Egypt.

Handwriting is still very important, please help your child to use their neatest writing in their homework. When reading with your child please talk about what has been read to check understanding. A commitment of 15 minutes per evening spent on reading will make all the difference to your child's progress.

Maths

During Maths this term the children will be learning the expanded column method (the method most of us learnt at school). The children will be continuing their work on problem solving, investigations and working systematically to find a solution to a problem. The focus this half term is on securing place value and strategies for multiplication and division. Children should continue to practise their times tables x2, x3, x4, x5 and x10.



Foundation Subjects

In History we will be finding out about Ancient Egypt, which is our main topic this term. The Egyptian topic will also be covered in Art where we will be re-creating pieces of Egyptian art. Additionally, during ICT lessons the children will be learning how to code.

Homework

Spellings will be handed out on Mondays and be tested every Friday. Weekend homework will be handed out on Fridays and will consist of a comprehension task or a maths task, to be handed in on Mondays. Please read daily with your child and help them to practise their times tables.

PE is every Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure your child has their full kit in school from Monday to Friday.
