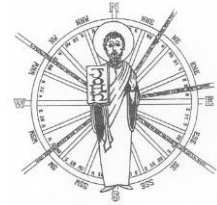

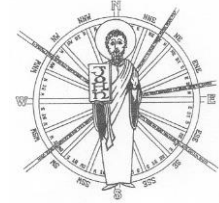
Children in St John's have taken part on the Summer Reading Challenge every year. This year the challenge has gone digital!

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Secondary School Transition

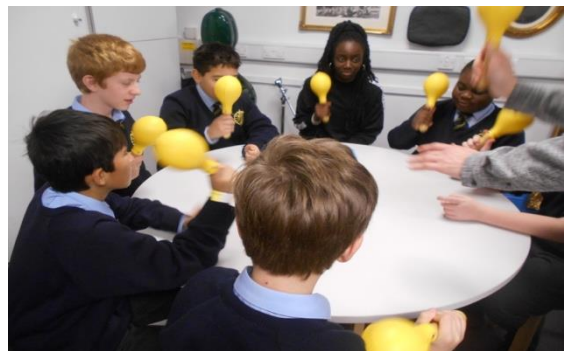
If your child has not been able to return to school you might like to [read this article here](#) in order to support their transition to secondary school.

We would like to take this opportunity to wish our Year 6 class the very best as they move to secondary school.



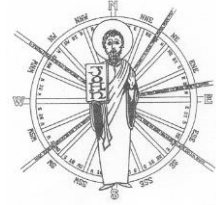
We appreciate the efforts they made as a class to be helpful, supportive and to be great role models to the younger children.
