Silly soup

How to carry out activity:

Have a selection of objects starting with the same letter/sound. Use a bowl and spoon as props to act out song. Invite your child to choose an object to put into the soup and place it in the bowl. After each turn, stir the soup and sing the following:

I'm making lots of silly soup,

I'm making soup that's silly,

I'm going to cook it in the fridge

To make it nice and chilly



In goes a...

(snake, sock, sausage, scissors, spider)


Encourage your child to think what else could go into our soup, it must start with 'sssss'.
