- What can you see in the picture?
- Where are the people going to?
- What are the people standing at the door doing?




Church's Story 2 (p.6-7)

Talk about what is happening in the picture from *Church's Story 1* (p.12+13)

When everyone is in their seats the priest enters. The people (or congregation) sing a gathering hymn.

The priest says 'The Lord be with you' and the people answer 'And with your Spirit'. Can you learn that response?

- What do you see in the picture? (people, altar servers, priest, crucifix, hymn books, benches, stained glass windows, candles)
- Who are the people in the picture? (the congregation)
- What are the Church family doing together?
- What is happening? (Priest and altar servers processing in)
