English

This term, Year 2 are starting with the book 'Tadpole's Promise' and the children will be writing about the life cycle of a frog. The class will then look at Roald Dahl's 'The Minpins' which is about tiny people who live in the woods. This will no doubt inspire some great creative writing.

Maths

Year 2 will continue to look at place value along with addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers up to 100 and beyond, using partitioning and empty number lines. The children will also be measuring mass in grams and kilograms. You can help by practising the 2,5 and 10 times tables at home.

Geography - The children will be exploring maps and learning about compass points
Science - Our topics are Living Things and Habitats. Year 2 will look at different habitats and what they provide.

ICT The children will learn to use search engines effectively to find information.
