New Roof

Over the past few years the condition of the school roof has deteriorated. We have had leaks on a regular basis that have been patched up, but this has now got to the stage where the whole roof requires replacing.

During the Easter holidays, these works will start. This will be a lengthy process with the first phase of construction currently estimated at 10 weeks (weather permitting), during which time the inner roof will be replaced. Contractors will NOT be entering the building once children return to site after the Easter break.

During this time we would appreciate your support and patience, particularly for parents who wait on and around the car park area. Please remain vigilant around the grounds and we thank you for your on-going co-operation.




Celebrating Success
