The Feast Day of Saint Peter & Saint Paul

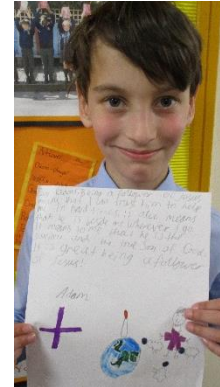
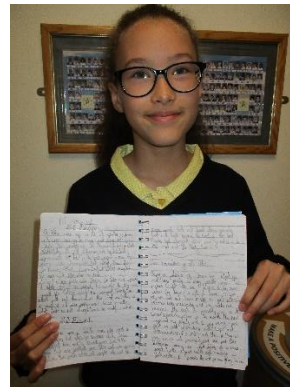
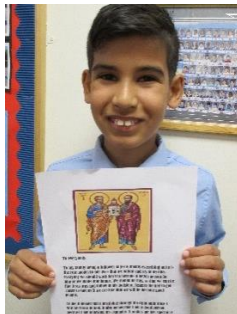

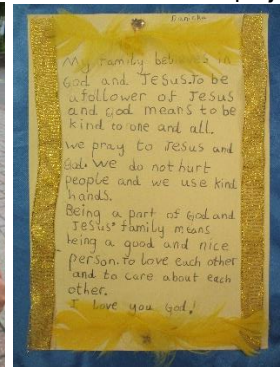
Last week all children in KS1 and KS2 were asked to find out about these two great saints and to think how their faith showed others what it was like to be a follower of Jesus.

The children had great fun and were very proud of the work they had produced.

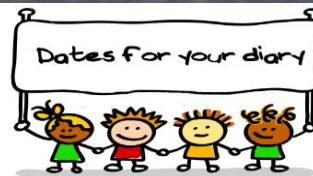


What a great day!
