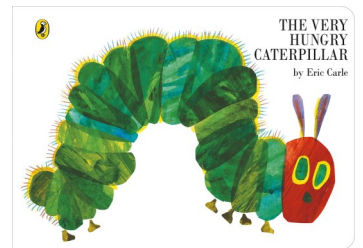
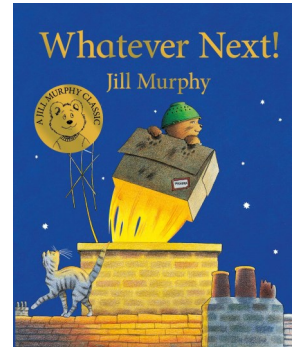
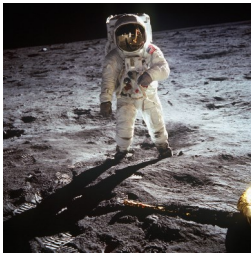


Nursery Newsletter Spring 2022

Spring Term Curriculum



This term we will be exploring two main themes Space and Growth. The first topic will invite children to understand planet Earth from above and to immerse themselves in the wonders of space exploration beyond our borders. We are going to build a space station and a large rocket, make space-related crafts and read stories linked to the topic such as 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy and 'Bob's Best Ever Friend' by Simon Bartram. We will also be asking key questions that hopefully would spark children's curiosity and imagination to explore even further in their quest to understand the world and our place within it.

In the Growth theme after half term, we will be exploring the changes happening all around us due to the arrival of Spring. Children will be planting seeds and see them growing which will give them the opportunity to understand and care for all forms of life. Books to be read during this term are 'Spring Is Here' by Heidi Pross Gray, and 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' by Eric Carle.

You can help your child to develop interests in these topics by reading these theme-related stories together with them at home.
