We are very fortunate that so many children applied for positions of responsibility at the school. At today's assembly those children voted for by their peers have been appointed. More details will follow in the coming weeks.

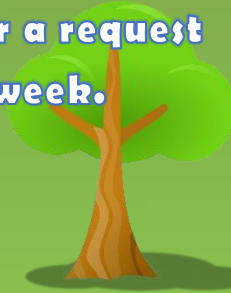


CELEBRATING SUCCESS
