This week the children had a very special workshop from HSBC teaching them how to be responsible with their money, discussing financial literacy and sharing hints and tips on budgeting.

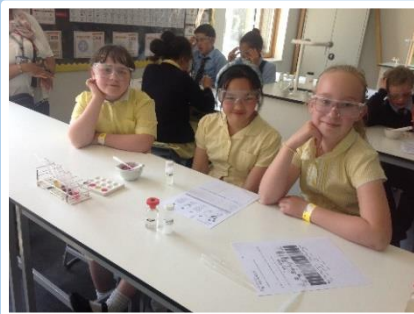


They spoke to younger children about different types of money, and then got more in depth into finances with the older children.

The children were praised for their amazing behaviour at a recent lockdown practice – congratulations to them.

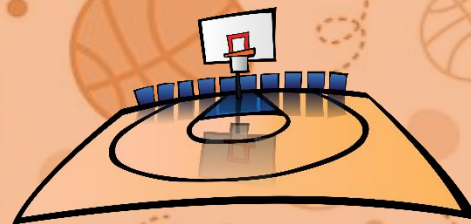
