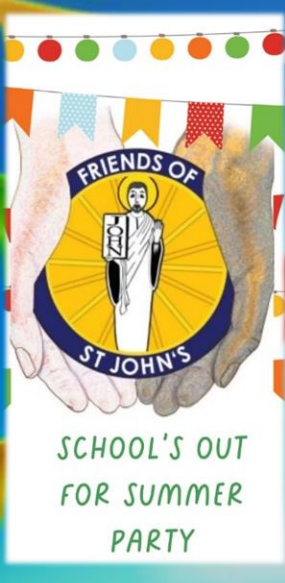


Congratulations to Mr Burns for being awarded a Master's degree in Catholic Leadership; the culmination of hard work and extra study!
