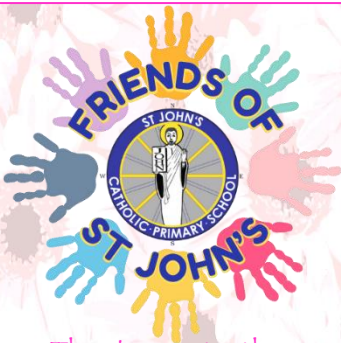


In this week's assembly, children learned that:
