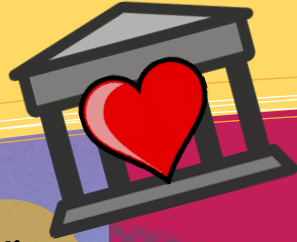

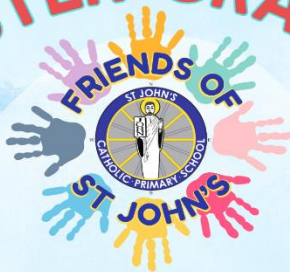
God has promised His people throughout history that He will be close to them.

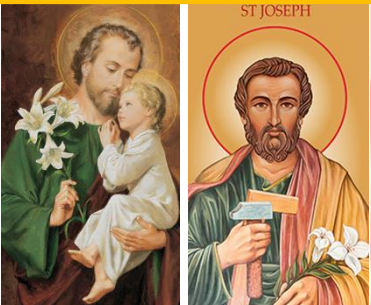
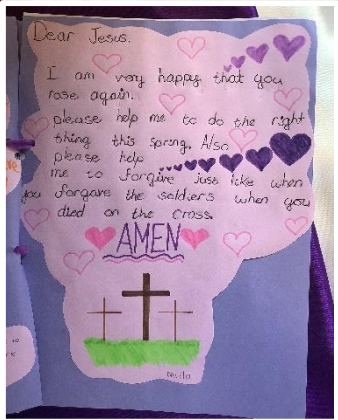
