


Welcome back to all of the children and their families. We were so pleased to see all of the children coming into school in the morning.

#### **Handwriting/Presentation**

With the publication of the new Writing Framework in July 2025, we are starting the new school year with an extra focus on handwriting and presentation.

To support your child's progress, we encourage you to continue practising at home. A few helpful tips for good handwriting include:

- **Posture:** Ensure your child is sitting upright with both feet flat on the floor.
- **Grip:** Encourage a relaxed but firm pencil grip using the thumb, index, and middle fingers.
- Paper position: The paper should be tilted slightly, depending on whether your child is right- or lefthanded.
- **Letter formation:** Remind your child to form letters from top to bottom and left to right.
- **Spacing:** Encourage leaving equal spaces between words for clarity.
- **Slow and steady:** Quality is more important than speed—neatness will improve with practice.
