I am doing your will.



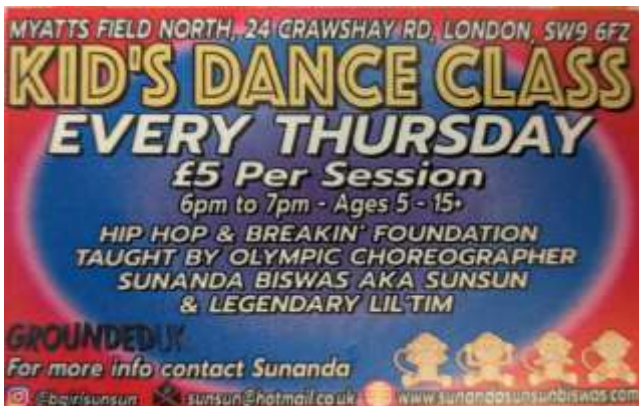
As the end of the school year has been approaching We have had quite a relaxed attitude to school uniform, however from September pupils are expected to return to school in the full, correct uniform.
