Since January, there has been a rise in measles cases. Measles is a highly contagious infection that spreads easily among unvaccinated people. It begins with fever and cold-like symptoms, followed by a rash. Around 1 in 5 children need hospital care, and complications can include pneumonia, meningitis, seizures, and blindness.

The MMR and MMRV vaccines are safe, free, and given in two doses at 12 and 18 months, though it's never too late to catch up. Vaccination protects your child and vulnerable people in the community.

Check your child's Red Book, the NHS app, or contact your GP. If needed, book a free vaccination appointment as soon as possible by calling 020 8614 5496

Children can dress up as a book character. In school we will have a parade and assembly.


