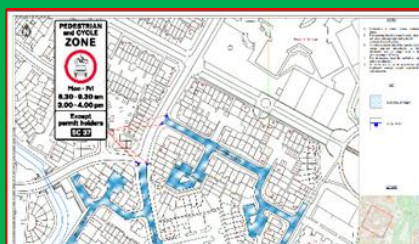
Year 5 Assembly

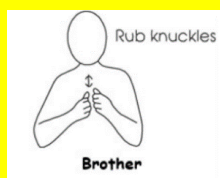
