In our final Eastertide assembly, we heard that on the night of Jesus' arrest, He lifted His eyes in prayer, and was fully focused on God the Father's will.

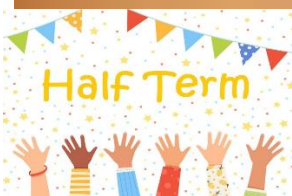
We are all invited to lift up our eyes and turn to God in prayer, just as Jesus.
