full'?



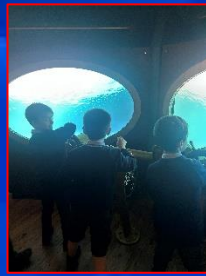
WELL DONE MISS KELLY
