On Tuesday, Nursery celebrated the conclusion of our year-long composting inquiry with an exhibition showcasing the children's learning journey, from a simple question, "Where's the bin?", to show the children how food waste can be transformed into compost to grow new life. Throughout the year, the children have observed the changes over time, explored decomposition, cared for the plants, and discovered how their everyday actions can positively impact the environment. The exhibition invited families to reflect on this journey and encouraged them to continue these conversations at home.

As a lasting reminder of the project, 24 families took home a tomato plant grown using our Nursery-made compost, extending the children's learning beyond the classroom and promoting environmental responsibility within the wider community.
